



Figuring out your bracelet size...

To ensure a proper fit, please use the following guidelines to help you select the appropriate bracelet size.

First, determine your wrist size

- Find a piece of string or cut a strip of paper about a ¼" wide.
- Wrap the string/paper around your wrist just below the wrist bone. The fit should be snug but not tight.
- Mark the string or paper where it overlaps to form a complete circle around your wrist.
- With a ruler, measure the length of string or paper to determine your wrist size.

Next, determine how much "give" to add and pick a size

For Link Bracelets: Keep in mind that all of our bracelets are measured end-to-end, including the clasp. The actual length may vary by a ¼" from the length listed. Consider how snug or loose fitting you want your bracelet when determining how much to add to your wrist measurement. For a snug fit, we suggest adding ½" to your wrist size. For a loose fit, we suggest adding 1" to your wrist size. Keep in mind that larger link bracelets will fit more tightly than thin bracelets.

size	bracelet length
S - Small	7.0" bracelet length
M - Medium	7.5" bracelet length
L - Large	8.0" bracelet length
XL - X-Large	8.5" bracelet length

For Cuff Bracelets: Consider how snug or loose fitting you want your cuff bracelet. Keep in mind that our cuff bracelets are intended to be worn snugly around your wrist with a 1-1¼" opening. If you prefer to wear your cuff loosely like a bangle, we suggest you order up one to two sizes from your recommended size.

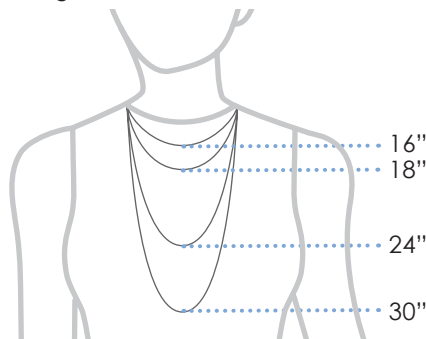
wrist size	recommended size
6.0-6.5" actual wrist size	S - Small
6.5-7.0" actual wrist size	M - Medium
7.0-7.5" actual wrist size	L - Large
7.5-8.0" actual wrist size	XL - X-Large

Ordering a gift?

Don't have the gift recipient's wrist available for handy measurement? Try measuring the recipient's watch or bracelet. Otherwise, you can try using our size chart as a rough guideline to make your decision. Please keep in mind that these are approximations and not a guarantee for a perfect fit. If in doubt, we generally recommend ordering a larger size since removing links can be handled by a local jeweler and cuffs cannot be lengthened.

Figuring out your necklace size...

When selecting an appropriate necklace length, consider that the length will determine where the necklace will lie on your chest. Remember that longer lengths accentuate the bust while shorter lengths highlight the area around the neckline. All of our necklaces are measured end-to-end, including the clasp. Actual length may vary by a ¼" from the length listed.



length	name	description
16"	Choker	Falls just above the collar bone
18"	Princess	Falls just below the base of the neck
24"	Matinee	Falls at the center of the chest
30"	Opera	Falls at the breastbone
